CCWSC WATER DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

What's happening this month

- All PayClix issues have been resolved if you have a locked off account and an active account you will want to re-establish your PayClix account if you want to have autopay enabled.
- Assessment updates: Co-Bank approved our leasing loan and are working directly with G & W Engineering to get invoicing and making direct payments to vendors.
- We have put an assessment snapshot on our website under the financial tab so you can see our progress to date on revenue and expenses.
- G & W Engineering has started the 120k gallon ground water storage tank replacement project. We have already had soil samples taken for the tank foundation. Clark Constructor's will be doing the demolition of the old tank next. We will be salvaging the ladder and electric panel to be re-used.
- 2,500-gallon pressure tank is currently being researched to either refurbish or replace with a 5k gallon pressure tank. CCWSC is being proactive reviewing a higher capacity tank for compliance with near future connections.

We want to welcome Teresa Payne and Dolores Chandler to CCWSC. Teresa Payne will be working Monday-Tuesday and Dolores will be working Wednesday-Thursday. They will be running the day-to-day operations and book-keeping.
